HOBY KY Packing List

Required Items:

- Bed linens: twin xl sheets, blankets or sleeping bag, pillow case
- Pillow
- Bath Towels
- Toiletries: shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, personal care products
- Hand sanitizer, masks, and disinfectant wipes (for personal use only)
- Clothing
 - o Casual, comfortable clothing: shirts, shorts, jeans/long pants, etc.
 - You will receive 2 HOBY t-shirts at check in. They will be worn on Friday & Saturday.
 - Shorts should be fingertip length and tank tops should have one-inch straps.
 - Hats will not be allowed during indoor speakers/events.
 - o Business casual attire for Sunday
 - button up, slacks, dress, skirt, etc.
- Sturdy walking shoes (at least 1 pair should be closed-toe for service projects)
- Prescription & OTC Medication *see notes below*
- One sheet of postage (10 Stamps)
- Hygiene products to donate for a service project. Products include toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, hair brush, soap, sunscreen, feminine products, hand sanitizer, deodorant, body wash, etc.
- Any completed pre-seminar forms or fees that were not previously provided to us (typically only applies only to late registrants)

Suggested Items:

- Shower shoes (student will be in a dorm with communal showers and restrooms)
- Robe
- Hair dryer
- Jacket, sweatshirt or other long sleeve shirts
- Small amount of spending money (optional for items available during the weekend)
- Camera
- Water bottle
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Umbrella and/or raincoat
- Backpack

It is suggested that students "pack light." Due to Berea policy, parents will only be allowed on the ground floor of student dormitories. **Students must be able to pack all of their luggage.**

Prescription Medication:

If applicable, be sure to bring any prescription medication. Please bring only as much medication as will reasonably be needed during the HOBY event (3 days). Medication must be in its **original** container as labeled by the pharmacy. A Medication Verification Form for Physicians must be on file for all prescription medications. Please refer to the Policy for Use of Medication During a HOBY Event included in the pre-seminar materials for more information.

Check In:

Check in will start at 10:30 a.m. on June 6 and end at 1:00 p.m. Please make every effort to arrive during that time frame. Please do not arrive expecting to check in prior to 10:30 a.m. Check in and room assignments will be handled out at check in. We do not take roommate requests. Only one parent/guardian may accompany an ambassador during check-in.

Facilities & Lodging Fee (Required):
